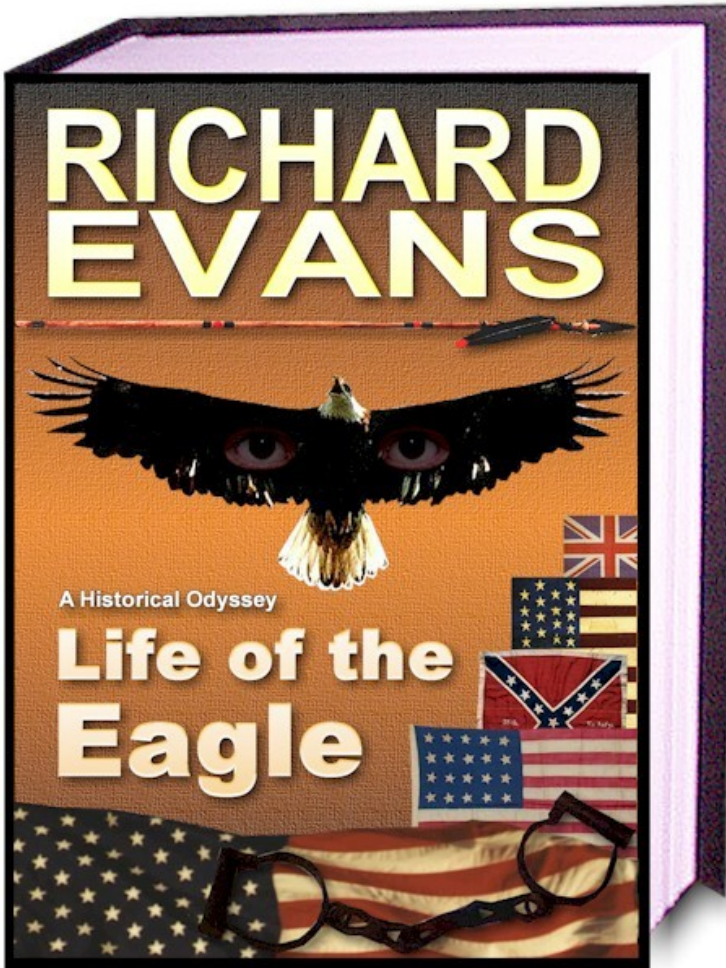


Life Of the Eagle
